BLM Seeking Public Input on Comprehensive Travel Management

The BLM is holding three public meetings in Arizona to discuss comprehensive travel management for the Bumble Bee, Table Mesa, Lake Pleasant and San Domingo Wash areas. The purpose for the meetings is to inform the public of the designation process, describe the type of input from the public that would be helpful and present the general schedule leading to final route designations. Both motorized and nonmotorized trail users are invited. Maps will be available. Input from the public regarding route connectivity, existing conflicts and current or desired access will be taken. This is your opportunity to give your ideas for

a travel route system in the subject areas. Input regarding route designations will be accepted through June 30, 2007. The outcome of this process will be a draft travel management map for public review to be released in the fall.
